Award Criteria:

- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Involvement in humanitarian project or organization

Nomination Process:

Nominations for the College of Applied Studies Undergraduate Humanitarian of the Year Award can be made by any member of the College, including self-nomination, fellow students, faculty, or staff. The nomination consists of written responses to the stated questions, a current resume of the nominee, and documentation of service performed.
