Students apply the processes of goal and objective technology and selection of sequencing activities in creating a program design within recreation and leisure services.

“*Applied Recreation Programming*” (LEI 3403) this course was the practical lab to LEI 3435, Recreation Program Design. Students design and physically implement a recreational program.

“*Event Planning*” (LEI 4932) this course encouraged students to develop the skills to be able to produce a successful special event from beginning to end. It focuses on the planning and operations of various types of events.
